Nicholas (Nick) Cammarata was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL) on July 4, 2008. After a very hard and courageous battle, Nick passed away on October 26, 2008. He was an eighth grade student at Gowana Middle School in the Shenendehowa School District. Nick would have graduated in 2013.

Nick had a quirky sense of humor, easy manner with people, and loved to make everyone laugh. This ability to evoke laughter, even at his own expense, was an example of Nick's self-confidence and his love of life. Nick never cared what others thought of him. He lived life on his own track, which was often off the beaten path. Nick's charisma encompassed how he lived. If people couldn't be like him, they wanted to follow him. Nick led by being himself and being sensitive to others.

Nick was compassionate and empathetic. He had this innate sense of knowing when a person was sad or needed support. Nick would lend a hand even if to give someone a hug. His peers remember the times he picked up their books after dropping them in the hall or protected them from being bullied. He believed in standing up for others and encouraged them to do the same.

An avid Lego builder, Nick was involved in robotics, enjoyed video games and any type of technology. Since he loved helping others, he planned to be a technology teacher. Two scholarships will be awarded to two 2018 graduates of Shenendehowa Central School district who are interested in furthering their education in a two or four-year institution and plan to use technology in a creative way in order to improve their performance both inside and outside the classroom. Through this difficult time, he still had compassion for those helping him each day, along with his strength and determination to fight cancer. This scholarship is in memory of Nick and reflects his values and personality. By helping other children with cancer, his spirit lives on. He had these qualities even on the most difficult days of his "Fight to be Healed."

Scholarship Criteria

Scholarship recipients must meet the following criteria:

- Have an interest in using technology to improve the world around them;
- Reflect some of Nick's qualities: helping others even if he didn't know them; courage; compassion; strength; leadership; determination; never giving up as he knew "nothing is impossible;" a desire to give back to the community, especially those battling cancer;
- Be a senior from the 2018 graduating class of Shenendehowa Central School; and
- Attend a two-year or four-year school in Fall 2018.

1. Submit an essay of 500 words or less describing how you would creatively use technology to help others and/or improve the world around you to make it a better place, especially for future generations.
2. Submit two letters of recommendation reflecting your character; and
3. Complete the attached application and submit with essay and letters of recommendation.

There will be two \$1,000 scholarships awarded to seniors from the 2018 graduating class of Shenendehowa Central School.
